Remote Learning Offer

Teacher Led Lessons

Lessons will be pre-recorded and be sent out in advance to allow them to be accessed at the most appropriate time for families. Children will be able to watch the video lessons, pause them where necessary and re-watch them if appropriate. Differentiated activities for the children to complete will be explained in the video.

Pre-recorded videos will be shared daily. These will include:

- Daily pre-recorded Phonic lessons
- Daily pre-recorded story
- Weekly Literacy video alongside daily tasks
- Weekly Maths video alongside daily tasks

How the work will be set:

The lessons and relevant resources will be sent to parents/carers via Microsoft Teams. Where possible, the printing of resources will not be needed and activities can be completed around the house. It will be clear from each session about how work should be completed.

Communication

Each child will receive their own Microsoft Teams account and login (to be controlled by parents / carers). Communication can be made through the 'chat' function or via submitted work. If parent/carers are having difficulty with this they can email the school office (office@ashbyhastingsprimary.co.uk). Problems will be addressed as reasonably possibly.

Accessing remote education

We recognise that some children may not have suitable online access at home. We have a limited supply of iPads that we can lend out with prior arrangement as well as codes to support you with Wi-Fi. Please contact the school office for more information.

What to do when an activity is complete

It is important that we know how your children are getting on with the lessons and activities set. Please give feedback via Teams. We expect children to access as many activities as possible and let us know what they have done. We do however understand that every family has different challenges.

Additional Support for children with SEND

We will support these children by tailoring planned activities or providing additional resources to meet their needs and ensure that these are delivered in a way that they can access.

What else do we offer?

Every day there will be a Teams live meeting with the class teacher at 9:30am. This will be an opportunity for virtual face to face contact. In these meetings teachers may read stories, set fun activities, play games etc.

If this remote learning offer becomes active children will be provided with an 'activity mat' that will include a variety of activities to complete for the first two days of remote learning. This will allow us time to set each child up with their Teams account and ensure everyone is set up and ready.
